2019 Emergency Exercise Notification

Moorabbin Airport is undertaking its annual emergency exercise on Tuesday 3 December 2019 between 9:30am and 1:00pm.

As a result, multiple emergency service personnel and vehicles will be visible on the airfield and throughout the aviation precincts.

The objectives of the exercise include:

- testing the validity of the Moorabbin Airport Aerodrome Emergency Plan (AEP);
- statutory safety compliance;
- communications between MAC and responding emergency agencies; and
- practicing the establishment of a multi agency command centre.

Aircraft operations will continue as normal. The Moorabbin Airport Corporation office will be closed during the event.
