## Note

Under The Airports Act 1996: Airports (protection of Air Space) Regulations, any activity that infringes protected airspace is called a "CONTROLLED ACTIVITY" and requires approval before it can be carried out.

Controlled activities include:

- Permanent structures (e.g., buildings, masts, antenna)
- Temporary structures (e.g., cranes, scaffolding)
- Any activity that causes intrusions into protected airspace (e.g., glare from artificial light or reflected sun- light, air turbulence, smoke, dust or steam)

Carrying out a controlled activity without approval is an offence under section 183 of the AIRPORTS ACT with a fine up to 250 penalty points.
